Training Schedule**

- 1. Application Process: find application online at [www.fdu.edu/motorcycle](http://www.fdu.edu/motorcycle)**
  - a. Leave Name, Email address, phone number for Program Director
  - b. Go to “Become a RiderCoach” page (link is along left margin)
  - c. Fill out application and Fax to 201-692-6505
  - d. Wait to be called for an Interview
- 2. Interview Process: FDU Motorcycle Program will setup time to interview**
- 3. Candidates will be notified of acceptance into program within two weeks**
- 4. Accepted candidates Enrollment Process:**
  - a. Register with Payment in Full at Office of Continuing Education
  - b. Meet with FDU representative to receive Course Materials
    - i. Sign Receipt of Material form and have FDU representative sign
    - ii. RCG with BRC Rider Handbook, BRC Range Cards
    - iii. Receive Pre-course Assignment and Instructions
      1. Pre-course is due by April 15, 2009 (postmarked)
      2. Return to FDU in SASE or in person
    - iv. 2008 Course Schedule
      1. Observe BRC: email [ridesafe@fdu.edu](mailto:ridesafe@fdu.edu) with dates
  - c. Apply to State for RiderCoach status (fingerprinting/background check 1<sup>st</sup>)
  - d. Attend Orientation, if appropriate
  - e. Clear your calendar for Thursday, April 30 (6 p.m. start), 2009
    - May 1, 2, 3 Friday through Sunday
    - May 8, 9 (Friday and Saturday)
    - May 15, 16, 17 (Friday through Sunday – Student Teaching)
      - i. 9 a.m. Start – Intro, then BRC for the RiderCoach candidates
      - ii. Skills Evaluation
      - iii. Peer Teaching
  - f. Get plenty of sleep and STUDY HARD for following weekend
    - i. Peer Teaching and Q/A
    - ii. Knowledge Test
  - g. Last weekend of Student Teaching
    - i. Arrive 10 AM for review
    - ii. Get lunch and dinner
    - iii. Arrive early for set-up
    - iv. 6 p.m.: Teach actual novice riders under RCT supervision
    - v. Success = MSF certification
