

Today's NJ Nursing Scholars... Are Tomorrow's Nursing Faculty

The New Jersey Nursing Initiative Faculty Preparation Program is offering an exciting opportunity to become a nurse faculty member. As a Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF) New Jersey Nursing Scholar, you will prepare for a rewarding career teaching the next generation of nurses in the state. Support is available as you earn a Master of Science degree in nursing:

- **Fairleigh Dickinson University:**

Adult Nurse Practitioner with additional preparation in education

- **Monmouth University:**

Nursing Education with additional preparation in a clinical specialty

If you are selected for this program, you will receive a scholarship covering tuition and fees, and a \$50,000 per year stipend to cover living expenses for the two years you spend as a fulltime student.

Each scholar will also receive a laptop computer and PDA.

To Be Eligible, You Must:

- 1) Meet admission requirements, be accepted and enroll as a full-time student in a Master of Science program at one of the following programs:
 - Fairleigh Dickinson University: Adult Nurse Practitioner
 - Monmouth University: Nursing Education
- 2) Never have taken graduate level courses
- 3) Be a United States citizen or permanent resident
- 4) Submit an application, along with a two-page, double-spaced essay, by February 27, 2010

If accepted, New Jersey Nursing Scholars must:

- 1) Enroll and matriculate in a full-time progression of courses in an advanced nursing program each semester
- 2) Maintain a GPA of 3.0 (B grade)
- 3) Participate in curriculum acculturation/socialization activities as planned by the New Jersey Nursing Education Collaborative and with your assigned faculty member
- 4) Participate in evaluation activities
- 5) Upon graduation, make a three-year commitment to serve as a full-time faculty member in a New Jersey based pre-licensure nursing program

Begin Your Studies:

The second cohort of New Jersey Nursing Scholars will study from fall 2010 to spring 2012.
