Recommendations Three letters of recommendation are required and may be submitted separately.

They must include the name and affiliation (i.e., university or place of business) of the person submitting the letter.

- Two of the letters must be from persons who can address your academic qualifications.
- One letter must be from an employer who can verify your form of homeland security employment.

GPA (Grade Point Average) All undergraduate and graduate averages must be listed including current near-graduation average. An undergraduate or graduate GPA of 3.0 or above must have been maintained to be considered for admission.

Test Scores No required GMAT or GRE scores. International students must take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

Essay Attach a written 1,000-word essay outlining your current job responsibilities, duties and management philosophy.

Résumé A current résumé must accompany this form.
